Note: For tickets originating in the USA, Canada, Brazil, all routes within TC3 are exempted from the fuel surcharge.

- Applicable to all international passenger tickets issued on and after October 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008.
- Infant without a seat is exempt from the surcharge.
- The surcharge applies to flights operated by Japan Airlines and its international subsidiary JALways, including JAL code-share flights operated by other airlines.
- In the case of refunds, the fuel surcharge will be refunded in full.
- Above information is subject to change without prior notice.
